(Columbia – MO) Art in the Park is a 47-year old fine arts festival presented by the Columbia Art League. This event, located at the historic Stephens College campus, is the oldest and largest fine arts festival in mid-Missouri.

The festival features more than 100 visual artists from across the United States displaying a variety of media including painting, drawing, photography, pottery, jewelry, fibers, sculpture, wood, and glass.

Families will find something for every age in the special hands-on art activity areas. Children enjoy print making, painting, a juggler, a balloon sculpture artist, a clown, and much more. They can also enjoy storytellers and magic shows on the entertainment stage.
