Championing films that breathe new life into the nonfiction format, the festival features the finest new movies redefining the now-exploding form.

Three days of thrilling nonfiction film call for active, participatory viewing of movies that blur the line between fact and fantasy, documentary and narrative, propaganda and journalism.

Dispelling the notion that documentaries are stuffy and dry, the True/False fest will honor lively work that evades easy categorization.

Festivities will unfold at a handful of venues in downtown Columbia — all within easy walking distance from each other — including the 1,200-seat movie palace, the Historic Missouri Theatre; the 300-seat Blue Note nightclub; and the intimate 85-seat Ragtag Cinema.

The festival HQ will be Cherry Street Artisan café, home to panel discussions, conversations, and an interactive "video confessional," all free and open to the public.
